4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 403.016, Government Code, is amended by
6	amending Subsections (b), (c), and (f) and adding Subsections (f-1)
7	and (f-2) to read as follows:
8	(b) The comptroller shall use the electronic funds transfer
9	system to pay an employee's net state salary and travel expense
10	reimbursements [unless:
11	[(1) the employee does not hold a classified position
12	under the state's position classification plan and the employee's
13	gross state salary is less than the gross state salary for a
14	position classified to group 8, step 1, of the state position
15	classification plan; or
16	[(2) the employee holds a classified position under the
17	state's position classification plan that is classified below group
18	8].
19	(c) The comptroller shall use the electronic funds transfer

system to make:

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Employees Retirement System of $Texas_{\underline{I}}$ [$ext{ex}$] the Teacher Retirement

System of Texas, or the Texas Emergency Services Retirement System

under each [either] system's administrative jurisdiction;

(1) payments of more than \$100 to annuitants by the

- 1 (2) recurring payments to municipalities, counties,
- 2 political subdivisions, special districts, and other governmental
- 3 entities of this state; and
- 4 (3) payments to vendors who choose to receive payment
- 5 through the electronic funds transfer system rather than by
- 6 warrant.
- 7 (f) $[\frac{1}{1}]$ Except as provided by Subsection (f-1)
- 8 [Subdivisions (2) and (4)] and subject to any limitation in rules
- 9 adopted by the comptroller, an automated clearinghouse, or the
- 10 federal government, the comptroller may use the electronic funds
- 11 transfer system to deposit payments only to one or more accounts of
- 12 a payee at one or more financial institutions, including credit
- 13 unions.
- (f-1) $[\frac{(2)}{(2)}]$ The comptroller may also use the electronic
- 15 funds transfer system to deposit $\underline{\text{the amount}}$ [$\frac{\text{a portion}}{\text{an}}$] of an
- 16 employee's payroll deduction made as authorized by law [gross pay
- 17 into the employee's account at a credit union as prescribed by
- 18 Subchapter G, Chapter 659].
- 19 (f-2) [(3)] A single electronic funds transfer may contain
- 20 payments to multiple payees. Individual transfers or warrants are
- 21 not required for each payee.
- [(4) The comptroller may also use the electronic funds
- 23 transfer system to deposit a portion of an employee's gross pay into
- 24 an account of an eligible state employee organization for a
- 25 membership as prescribed by Subchapter G, Chapter 659.
- 26 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 27 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
