1-14 AN ACT

1-15 relating to a prohibition on the imposition by an appraisal
1-16 district or the appraisal review board for an appraisal district of
1-17 a fee in connection with a protest filed with the board.

1-18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-19 SECTION 1. Section 41.41, Tax Code, is amended by adding
1-20 Subsection (c) to read as follows:

1-21 (c) An appraisal district or the appraisal review board for
1-22 an appraisal district may not require a property owner to pay a fee
1-23 in connection with a protest filed by the owner with the board.

1-24 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-25 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-26 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-27 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-28 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
