4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 402.043, Government Code, is amended to
6	read as follows:
7	Sec. 402.043. QUESTIONS RELATING TO ACTIONS IN WHICH THE
8	STATE IS INTERESTED. The attorney general shall advise <u>an</u> [a
9	district or county] attorney [of this state], on the attorney's
10	request, in the prosecution or defense of an action in which the
11	state is interested before a district or inferior court if $\underline{:}$
12	(1) the requesting attorney has investigated the
13	question involved and submitted a brief to the attorney general:
14	<u>and</u>
15	(2) the requesting attorney is:
16	(A) a district or county attorney; or
17	(B) an employee of a county who serves as the head
18	of the county's civil legal department.
19	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
20	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
21	provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
22	Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
23	Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
