A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 1 AN ACT
- 2 relating to procedures and requirements for the issuance of
- 3 certificates of obligation.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 271.047(d), Local Government Code, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (d) Except as provided by this subsection, the governing
- 8 body of an issuer may not authorize a certificate to pay a
- 9 contractual obligation to be incurred if a bond proposition to
- 10 authorize the issuance of bonds for the same purpose was submitted
- 11 to the voters during the preceding six [three] years and failed to
- 12 be approved. A governing body may authorize a certificate that the
- 13 governing body is otherwise prohibited from authorizing under this
- 14 subsection:
- 15 (1) in a case described by Sections 271.056(1)-(3);
- 16 and
- 17 (2) to comply with a state or federal law, rule, or
- 18 regulation if the political subdivision has been officially
- 19 notified of noncompliance with the law, rule, or regulation.
- 20 SECTION 2. Section 271.049, Local Government Code, is
- 21 amended by amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (e) to
- 22 read as follows:
- 23 (a) Regardless of the sources of payment of certificates,
- 24 certificates may not be issued unless the issuer publishes notice

- 1 of its intention to issue the certificates. The notice must be 2 published:
- 3 (1) once a week for two consecutive weeks in a
- 4 newspaper, as defined by Subchapter C, Chapter 2051, Government
- 5 Code, that is of general circulation in the area of the issuer, with
- 6 the date of the first publication to be before the 30th day before
- 7 the date tentatively set for the passage of the order or ordinance
- 8 authorizing the issuance of the certificates; and
- 9 (2) continuously on the issuer's Internet website for
- 10 at least 30 days before the date tentatively set for the passage of
- 11 the order or ordinance authorizing the issuance of the
- 12 <u>certificates</u>.
- 13 (e) An issuer shall maintain an Internet website to comply
- 14 with this section.
- 15 SECTION 3. Section 271.049, Local Government Code, as
- 16 amended by this Act, applies only to a certificate of obligation for
- 17 which the first notice of intention to issue the certificate is made
- 18 on or after the effective date of this Act. A certificate of
- 19 obligation for which the first notice of intention to issue the
- 20 certificate is made before the effective date of this Act is
- 21 governed by the law in effect on the date the notice of intention is
- 22 made, and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 23 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
