4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 29.0112(b), Education Code, is amended
6	to read as follows:
7	(b) The transition and employment guide must be written in
8	plain language and contain information specific to this state
9	regarding:
10	(1) transition services;
11	(2) employment and supported employment services;
12	(3) social security programs, including the Ticket to

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- Work Program authorized by the Ticket to Work and Work Incentives 13
- Improvement Act of 1999 (Pub. L. No. 106-170); 14
- (4) community and long-term services and support, 15
- including the option to place the student on a waiting list with a 16
- governmental agency for public benefits available to the student, 17
- such as a waiver program established under Section 1915(c), Social 18
- Security Act (42 U.S.C. Section 1396n(c)); 19
- 20 (5) postsecondary educational programs and services,
- 21 including the inventory maintained by the Texas Higher Education
- 22 Coordinating Board under Section 61.0663;
- information sharing with health and human services 23
- agencies and providers; 24

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- 1 (7) guardianship and alternatives to guardianship,
- 2 including a supported decision-making agreement under Chapter
- 3 1357, Estates Code;
- 4 (8) self-advocacy, person-directed planning, and
- 5 self-determination; [and]
- 6 (9) contact information for all relevant state
- 7 agencies;
- 8 (10) financial literacy, including information and
- 9 curricula on the effective long-term management of financial
- 10 resources; and
- 11 (11) financial independence, including:
- 12 (A) special needs trusts;
- 13 (B) the Texas Achieving a Better Life Experience
- 14 (ABLE) Program under Subchapter J, Chapter 54, authorized under
- 15 Section 529A, Internal Revenue Code of 1986;
- 16 (C) the Medicaid buy-in programs implemented
- 17 under Section 531.02444, Government Code; and
- 18 (D) other work incentive programs.
- 19 SECTION 2. This Act applies beginning with the 2020-2021
- 20 school year.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 25 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
