15	(2) initiate appropriate enforcement actions against									
16	those facilities.									
17	SECTION 2. As soon as possible after the effective date of									
18	this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human									
19	Services Commission shall establish the investigation unit									
20	required by Section 531.0084, Government Code, as added by this									
21	Act.									
22	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
