A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT
2 relating to authorization for the creation of a county ethics
3 commission in any county.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. This Act shall be cited as the J. D. Lambright
6 Local Government Ethics Reform Act.

7 SECTION 2. Section [161.001](#), Local Government Code, is
8 repealed.

9 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
10 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
11 provided by Section [39](#), Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
12 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
13 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
