1-21 relating to authorization for the creation of a county ethics

1-23 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-24 SECTION 1. This Act shall be cited as the J. D. Lambright
 1-25 Local Government Ethics Reform Act.

1-26 SECTION 2. Section 161.001, Local Government Code, is
 1-27 repealed.

1-28 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-29 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-30 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-31 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-32 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
