1-15 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
 1-16 AN ACT

1-17 relating to the prosecution of the offense of capital murder.
 1-18 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
 1-19 SECTION 1. This Act shall be known as Lauren's Law.
 1-20 SECTION 2. Section 19.03(a), Penal Code, is amended to read
 1-21 as follows:
 1-22 (a) A person commits an offense if the person commits murder
 1-23 as defined under Section 19.02(b)(1) and:
 1-24 (1) the person murders a peace officer or fireman who
 1-25 is acting in the lawful discharge of an official duty and who the
 1-26 person knows is a peace officer or fireman;
 1-27 (2) the person intentionally commits the murder in the
 1-28 course of committing or attempting to commit kidnapping, burglary,
 1-29 robbery, aggravated sexual assault, arson, obstruction or
 1-30 retaliation, or terroristic threat under Section 22.07(a)(1), (3),
 1-31 (4), (5), or (6);
 1-32 (3) the person commits the murder for remuneration or
 1-33 the promise of remuneration or employs another to commit the murder
 1-34 for remuneration or the promise of remuneration;
 1-35 (4) the person commits the murder while escaping or
 1-36 attempting to escape from a penal institution;
 1-37 (5) the person, while incarcerated in a penal
 1-38 institution, murders another:
 1-39 (A) who is employed in the operation of the penal
 1-40 institution; or
 1-41 (B) with the intent to establish, maintain, or
 1-42 participate in a combination or in the profits of a combination;
 1-43 (6) the person:
 1-44 (A) while incarcerated for an offense under this
 1-45 section or Section 19.02, murders another; or
 1-46 (B) while serving a sentence of life imprisonment
 1-47 or a term of 99 years for an offense under Section 20.04, 22.021, or
 1-48 29.03, murders another;
 1-49 (7) the person murders more than one person:
 1-50 (A) during the same criminal transaction; or
 1-51 (B) during different criminal transactions but
 1-52 the murders are committed pursuant to the same scheme or course of
 1-53 conduct;
 1-54 (8) the person murders an individual under 15 [~~10~~]
 1-55 years of age; or
 1-56 (9) the person murders another person in retaliation
 1-57 for or on account of the service or status of the other person as a
 1-58 judge or justice of the supreme court, the court of criminal
 1-59 appeals, a court of appeals, a district court, a criminal district
 1-60 court, a constitutional county court, a statutory county court, a
 1-61 justice court, or a municipal court.

2-1 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only
2-2 to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this Act.
2-3 An offense committed before the effective date of this Act is
2-4 governed by the law in effect on the date the offense was committed,
2-5 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose. For
2-6 purposes of this section, an offense was committed before the
2-7 effective date of this Act if any element of the offense occurred
2-8 before that date.

2-9 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
