## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to funding for prekindergarten programs at certain school
- 3 districts that operate early high school graduation programs.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 42.2527, Education Code, is amended to 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 42.2527. ADJUSTMENT FOR CERTAIN DISTRICTS WITH EARLY
- 8 HIGH SCHOOL GRADUATION PROGRAMS. (a) As a pilot program to enable
- 9 the state to evaluate the benefit of providing additional funding
- 10 at the prekindergarten level for [low-income] students who are
- 11 educationally disadvantaged, the commissioner shall provide
- 12 prekindergarten funding in accordance with this section to a school
- 13 district operating an early high school graduation program other
- 14 than a program under Section 28.0255 [located in a county that
- 15 borders the United Mexican States and the Gulf of Mexico].
- 16 (b) The commissioner shall provide funding for a school
- 17 district's prekindergarten program on a half-day basis for a number
- 18 of [ $\frac{1ow-income}{1}$ ] prekindergarten students who are educationally
- 19 <u>disadvantaged</u> equal to twice the number of students who received,
- 20 as a result of participation in an early high school graduation
- 21 program operated by the district, a high school diploma from the
- 22 district during the preceding school year after three years of
- 23 secondary school attendance.
- (c) The commissioner may adopt rules necessary to implement
