A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the administration, powers, and duties of certain
- 3 navigation districts.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 62, Water Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 62.0725 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 62.0725. EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR. (a) The commission may
- 8 employ an executive director of the district. If the commission
- 9 employs an executive director, the commission must prescribe the
- 10 duties and compensation of the executive director.
- 11 (b) By rule, order, or resolution, the commission may
- 12 delegate to an executive director the full authority necessary to
- 13 manage the affairs of the district subject only to orders of the
- 14 commission, including the authority to:
- 15 (1) employ persons necessary for the operation of the
- 16 district and to determine the compensation of those persons; or
- 17 (2) perform any act on behalf of the district, as
- 18 <u>authorized by the commission.</u>
- 19 (c) The duties of an executive director may be performed by
- 20 a general manager or chief executive officer.
- 21 SECTION 2. The heading to Section 62.077, Water Code, is
- 22 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 62.077. [ASSISTANT ENGINEERS AND EMPLOYEES;
- 24 COUNSEL[; SALARIES AND FEES].

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- 1 SECTION 3. Section 62.077(c), Water Code, is amended to
- 2 read as follows:
- 3 (c) The [amount of compensation for employees and] fees of
- 4 counsel shall be determined by the commission.
- 5 SECTION 4. Section 62.113, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 6 follows:
- 7 Sec. 62.113. FORM OF CONTRACTS. All contracts made by the
- 8 district [commission] shall be in writing and signed by the
- 9 contractors [and at least two of the commissioners], the executive
- 10 director of the district, [or] an authorized representative of the
- 11 executive director, or a person to whom the duties of executive
- 12 director have been delegated.
- SECTION 5. The heading to Section 62.115, Water Code, is
- 14 amended to read as follows:
- 15 Sec. 62.115. SUPERVISION OF WORK[+ REPORT].
- SECTION 6. Section 62.115(a), Water Code, is amended to
- 17 read as follows:
- 18 (a) Unless done under the supervision of the United States,
- 19 all work contracted for by the district [commission] shall be done
- 20 under the supervision of a representative of the district
- 21 [engineer].
- SECTION 7. Sections 62.116(a) and (b), Water Code, are
- 23 amended to read as follows:
- 24 (a) A representative of the district [The commission] shall
- 25 inspect the progress of work being done under a contract, and on
- 26 completion of the contract, the district's chief financial officer
- 27 [commission] shall draw a warrant on the county treasurer or issue a

- 1 <u>check</u> payable to the contractor or <u>the contractor's</u> [his] assignee
- 2 for the amount of the contract price. The warrant or check shall be
- 3 paid out of the construction and maintenance fund or the operating
- 4 <u>fund</u> of the district.
- 5 (b) If the district [commission] considers it advisable,
- 6 the district [it] may contract for work to be paid for in partial
- 7 payments as the work progresses. [The partial payments may not
- 8 exceed in the aggregate eighty percent of the total amount to be
- 9 paid under the contract.] The amount of work completed at the time
- 10 of the partial payment shall be shown by a certificate of \underline{a}
- 11 representative of the district [engineer].
- 12 SECTION 8. Section 62.122(a), Water Code, is amended to
- 13 read as follows:
- 14 (a) The [Except as provided by Subsection (b), the]
- 15 commission may authorize the executive director to sell, destroy,
- 16 donate, or otherwise dispose of the district's [periodically
- 17 dispose of surplus or salvage personal property by any method the
- 18 executive director or the executive director's designee determines
- 19 is in the best interest of the district [in the same manner as the
- 20 commissioners court of a county under Subchapter D, Chapter 263,
- 21 Local Government Code].
- SECTION 9. Section 62.152, Water Code, is amended to read as
- 23 follows:
- Sec. 62.152. PAYMENT OF EXPENSES [WARRANTS]. The district
- 25 [commission] may draw warrants or issue checks:
- 26 (1) to pay for [legal] services;
- 27 (2) to pay the compensation [salary] of [the engineer,

- 1 his assistant, and any other] employees; and
- 2 (3) to pay all expenses incident to operation of the
- 3 district.
- 4 SECTION 10. Section 62.153, Water Code, as amended by
- 5 Chapters 398 (S.B. 1131) and 427 (S.B. 1395), Acts of the 85th
- 6 Legislature, Regular Session, 2017, is reenacted and amended to
- 7 read as follows:
- 8 Sec. 62.153. DUTIES OF DISTRICT TREASURER. (a) The
- 9 district treasurer shall:
- 10 (1) open an account for all funds received by the
- 11 district treasurer for the district and all district funds which
- 12 the treasurer pays out;
- 13 (2) pay out money on vouchers signed by the chairman of
- 14 the commission, any two members of the commission, or the
- 15 commissioners court, or any two of any number of persons delegated
- 16 by the commission with authority to sign vouchers, provided that
- 17 the commission may, in such delegation, limit the authority of such
- 18 persons and may require that each furnish a fidelity bond in such
- 19 amount as the commission shall specify and subject to commission
- 20 approval;
- 21 (3) carefully preserve all orders for the payment of
- 22 money; and
- 23 (4) render a correct account to the commissioners
- 24 court of all matters relating to the financial condition of the
- 25 district as often as required by the commissioners court.
- 26 (b) The district treasurer is not[; and
- 27 [(5) not be] required to sign a check drawn on a

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- 1 depository selected under Section 62.156, unless the district
- 2 treasurer is the designated officer of the district, as defined by
- 3 Section 60.271(q).
- 4 (c) [(b)] A designated officer of a district may make a
- 5 payment on behalf of the district by a check drawn on a depository
- 6 selected under Section 62.155 in a manner consistent with the
- 7 payment procedures adopted under Section 60.271(f) without
- 8 authorization by the district treasurer.
- 9 SECTION 11. The following provisions of the Water Code are
- 10 repealed:
- 11 (1) Section 62.076;
- 12 (2) Section 62.077(a);
- 13 (3) Section 62.115(b); and
- 14 (4) Section 62.122(b).
- 15 SECTION 12. To the extent of any conflict, this Act controls
- 16 over another Act of the 86th Legislature, Regular Session, 2019,
- 17 relating to nonsubstantive additions to and corrections in enacted
- 18 codes.
- 19 SECTION 13. This Act takes effect immediately if it
- 20 receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each
- 21 house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution.
- 22 If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate
- 23 effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
