Except as otherwise provided by this subchapter, this [This] subchapter 8 9 applies only to a health benefit plan, including a small employer health benefit plan written under Chapter 1501, that provides 10 11 benefits for medical or surgical expenses incurred as a result of a 12 health condition, accident, or sickness, including an individual, group, blanket, or franchise insurance policy or insurance 13 agreement, a group hospital service contract, or an individual or 14 group evidence of coverage or similar coverage document that is 15 16 offered by: 17 an insurance company; 18 (2) a group hospital service corporation operating under Chapter 842; 19 20 (3) a fraternal benefit society operating under 21 Chapter 885; 22 (4) a stipulated premium company operating under 23 Chapter 884; 24 (5) a reciprocal exchange operating under Chapter 942;

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1 health benefits plan for children operated under Chapter 63, Health and Safety Code, the state Medicaid program, and a managed care 2 organization that contracts with the Health and Human Services 3 Commission to provide health care services to recipients through a 4 5 managed care plan shall provide the coverage required under this section to a recipient. 6 7 (f) A health benefit plan that provides benefits for a 8 prescription contraceptive drug must provide for an enrollee to obtain up to a 12-month supply of the covered prescription 9

10 contraceptive drug at one time.

11 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act applies only 12 to a health benefit plan that is delivered, issued for delivery, or 13 renewed on or after January 1, 2020. A health benefit plan that is 14 delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed before January 1, 2020, 15 is governed by the law as it existed immediately before the 16 effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for 17 that purpose.

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SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
