- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Sections 85.005(a) and (b), Family Code, are
- 5 amended to read as follows:
- 6 (a) To facilitate settlement, the parties to a proceeding
- 7 may agree in writing to  $[\frac{\text{the terms of}}{\text{terms of}}]$  a protective order as
- 8 provided by <u>Sections</u> [<del>Section</del>] 85.021 <u>and 85.022</u>. An agreement
- 9 under this subsection is subject to the approval of the court. The
- 10 court may not approve an agreement that requires the applicant for
- 11 the protective order to do or refrain from doing an act under
- 12 Section 85.022.
- 13 (b) An [<del>To facilitate settlement, a respondent may agree in</del>
- 14 writing to the terms of a protective order as provided by Section
- 15 85.022, subject to the approval of the court. The court may not
- 16 approve an agreement that requires the applicant to do or refrain
- 17 from doing an act under Section 85.022. The] agreed protective
- 18 order is enforceable civilly or criminally, regardless of whether
- 19 the court makes the findings required by Section 85.001.
- SECTION 2. Section 85.006(a), Family Code, is amended to
- 21 read as follows:
- 22 (a) Notwithstanding Rule 107, Texas Rules of Civil
- 23 Procedure, a [A] court may render a protective order that is binding
- 24 on a respondent who does not attend a hearing if:

- 1 (1) the respondent received service of the application
- 2 and notice of the hearing; and
- 3 (2) proof of service was filed with the court before
- 4 the hearing.
- 5 SECTION 3. Article 7A.01(a), Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (a) The following persons may file an application for a
- 8 protective order under this chapter without regard to the
- 9 relationship between the applicant and the alleged offender:
- 10 (1) a person who is the victim of an offense under
- 11 Section 20A.02, 20A.03, 21.02, 21.11, 22.011, 22.021, [or] 42.072,
- 12 <u>or 43.05</u>, Penal Code;
- 13 (2) any adult acting on behalf of a child or on behalf
- 14 of an adult ward who is the victim of an offense listed in
- 15 Subdivision (1) [a person who is the victim of an offense under
- 16 Section 20A.02, 20A.03, or 43.05, Penal Code]; or
- 17 (3) [a parent or guardian acting on behalf of a person
- 18 younger than 17 years of age who is the victim of an offense listed
- 19 in Subdivision (1);
- [(4) a parent or guardian acting on behalf of a person
- 21 younger than 18 years of age who is the victim of an offense listed
- 22 in Subdivision (2); or
- [(5)] a prosecuting attorney acting on behalf of a
- 24 person described by Subdivision (1)  $\underline{\text{or}}[\tau]$  (2)  $[\tau(3), \text{or}(4)]$ .
- 25 SECTION 4. Article 7A.07, Code of Criminal Procedure, is
- 26 amended by amending Subsection (b) and adding Subsection (c) to
- 27 read as follows:

- 1 (b) The following persons may file at any time an
- 2 application with the court to rescind the protective order:
- 3 (1) a victim of an offense listed in Article
- 4 7A.01(a)(1) who is 18[17] years of age or older;
- 5 (2) subject to Subsection (c), [er] a parent or
- 6 guardian acting on behalf of a victim of an offense listed in
- 7 Article 7A.01(a)(1) who is younger than 18 [17] years of age; or
- 8 (3) the person who filed the application for the
- 9 protective order.
- 10 <u>(c) A</u> [<del>(2) a victim of an offense listed in Article</del>
- 11  $\frac{7\text{A.Ol(a)(2) or a}}{2}$  parent or guardian may not file an application to
- 12 rescind the protective order under Subsection (b)(2) if the parent
- 13 or guardian is the alleged offender subject to the protective order
- 14 [acting on behalf of a victim who is younger than 18 years of age].
- 15 SECTION 5. Section 85.005, Family Code, as amended by this
- 16 Act, applies only to a protective order approved by the court on or
- 17 after the effective date of this Act.
- 18 SECTION 6. Section 85.006, Family Code, as amended by this
- 19 Act, applies only to a protective order for which the respondent
- 20 receives service on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 21 SECTION 7. Chapter 7A, Code of Criminal Procedure, as
- 22 amended by this Act, applies only to a protective order for which an
- 23 application is filed on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 24 SECTION 8. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
