## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

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- 2 relating to property insurance coverage for and the appraisal of 3 certain condominium properties.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 82.111, Property Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsections (b-1) and (b-2) to read as follows:
- 7 <u>(b-1) The association shall annually deliver to the unit</u> 8 owners in the manner determined appropriate by the board:
- 9 <u>(1)</u> a written summary of the material terms of the
- 10 property insurance coverage, if any, maintained under Subsection
- 11 (b) or (c) with respect to property described by Subsection (b),
- 12 including the amount of coverage; and
- 13 (2) a comparison of the property insurance coverage to
- 14 property coverage required by any applicable provisions of this
- 15 section.

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- 16 (b-2) Every 36 months the association shall retain an
- 17 independent appraiser to appraise and prepare an appraisal report
- 18 regarding property the association may insure or is required to
- 19 <u>insure under Subsection (b) or (c). As soon as practicable after</u>
- 20 the association receives the appraisal report, the association
- 21 shall deliver the report to the unit owners in a manner determined
- 22 appropriate by the board.
- SECTION 2. Not later than January 1, 2020, a condominium
- 24 association shall deliver to the unit owners the initial summary

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- 1 and comparison required by Section 82.111(b-1), Property Code, as
- 2 added by this Act, and the initial appraisal report required by
- 3 Section 82.111(b-2), Property Code, as added by this Act.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
