9 SECTION 3. (a) Section 801.261(a), Occupations Code, as 10 amended by this Act, applies only to an application for an equine 11 dental provider license submitted on or after September 1, 2020. An 12 application submitted before that date is governed by the law in 13 effect immediately before the effective date of this Act, and the 14 former law is continued in effect for that purpose.

(b) The change in law made by this Act to Section 801.261(a), Occupations Code, does not apply to the renewal of a license issued before September 1, 2020.
