5	SECTION 1. Chapter 551, Local Government Code, is amended
6	by adding Section 551.008 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 551.008. REGULATION OF DISPOSABLE PLASTIC BAG USE IN
8	CERTAIN MUNICIPALITIES. (a) Notwithstanding Section
9	361.0961(a)(1), Health and Safety Code, a municipality with a
10	population of less than 300,000 that holds a Phase I municipal
11	separate storm sewer system permit from the Texas Commission or
12	Environmental Quality may adopt an ordinance prohibiting or
13	restricting the use of disposable plastic bags if:
14	(1) the municipality, through its environmental
15	services department if applicable, issues a report on the proposed
16	ordinance's potential effects, including on the municipality's
17	storm sewer system;
18	(2) the findings of the report are presented at a
19	public hearing on the adoption of the proposed ordinance; and
20	(3) the municipality publishes on its Internet website
21	for reference by the public and other municipalities:
22	(A) the report; and
23	(B) periodic updates to the report with data and
24	other findings regarding the actual effects of the ordinance.

- 1 (b) An ordinance adopted under this section:
- 2 (1) may not include a new tax or fee related to the use
- 3 of disposable plastic bags;
- 4 (2) may not be effective for a period longer than three
- 5 years; and
- 6 (3) may be readopted if the requirements of this
- 7 <u>section are met.</u>
- 8 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
