## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
AN ACT
relating to class size limits and student/teacher ratios for
prekindergarten classes provided by or on behalf of public schools.
BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
SECTION 1. Section 25.112(a), Education Code, is amended to
read as follows:
(a) Except as otherwise authorized by this section, a school
district may not enroll more than 22 students in a prekindergarten,
kindergarten, first, second, third, or fourth grade class. That
limitation does not apply during:

- 11 (1) any 12-week period of the school year selected by
- 12 the district, in the case of a district whose average daily
- 13 attendance is adjusted under Section 42.005(c); or
- 14 (2) the last 12 weeks of any school year in the case of any other district.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter E, Chapter 29, Education Code, is
- 17 amended by adding Section 29.1535 to read as follows:
- 18 <u>Sec. 29.1535. STUDENT/TEACHER RATIOS. A school district</u>
- 19 that offers a prekindergarten program under Section 29.153 or a
- 20 private entity that provides a prekindergarten program under
- 21 contract with a school district must maintain an average ratio of:
- 22 (1) for a class of 16 students or more, not less than
- 23 one certified teacher or teacher's aide for each 11 students; and
- 24 (2) for a class of fewer than 16 students, at least one

- 1 <u>certified teacher or teacher's aide for each class.</u>
- 2 SECTION 3. Section 29.167(d), Education Code, is amended to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 (d) A school district must [attempt to] maintain an average
- 5 ratio in any prekindergarten program class of:
- 6 (1) for a class of 16 students or more, not less than
- 7 one certified teacher or teacher's aide for each 11 students; and
- 8 (2) for a class of fewer than 16 students, at least one
- 9 certified teacher or teacher's aide for each class.
- SECTION 4. Section 29.171(c), Education Code, is amended to
- 11 read as follows:
- 12 (c) A prekindergarten program provided by a private
- 13 provider under this section is subject to:
- 14 (1) the requirements of this subchapter, including the
- 15 student/teacher ratio requirements imposed under Section
- 16 <u>29.167(d); and</u>
- 17 (2) the class size requirement for prekindergarten
- 18 classes imposed under Section 25.112(a).
- 19 SECTION 5. This Act applies beginning with the 2019-2020
- 20 school year.
- 21 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 25 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
