## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the administration of a grant program to support

3 community mental health programs for veterans and their families.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Section 531.0992, Government Code, is amended by

amending Subsections (c) and (d) and adding Subsections (d-1) and

7 (d-2) to read as follows:

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- 8 (c) The commission [private entity that supports and
- 9 administers the grant program] shall ensure that each grant
- 10 recipient obtains or secures contributions to match awarded grants
- 11 in amounts of money or other consideration as required by
- 12 Subsection (d-1) or (d-2) [obtain or secure contributions to the
- 13 grant program in an amount of money or other consideration at least
- 14 equal in value to the amount of money awarded to grant recipients by
- 15 the commission under the grant program]. The money or other

consideration obtained or secured by the commission [private

- 17 entity] may, as determined by the executive commissioner, include
- 18 cash or in-kind contributions from private contributors or local
- 19 governments but may not include state or federal funds.
- 20 (d) Money appropriated to, or obtained by, the commission
- 21 for the grant program must be disbursed directly to grant
- 22 recipients by the commission, as authorized by the executive
- 23 commissioner. [Money or other consideration obtained or secured by
- 24 the private entity must be disbursed or provided directly to grant

- 1 recipients by the private entity, private contributors, or local
- 2 governments, as authorized by the executive commissioner.
- 3 (d-1) For services and treatment provided in a single
- 4 county, the commission shall condition each grant provided under
- 5 this section on a potential grant recipient providing funds from
- 6 <u>non-state sources in a total amount at least equal to:</u>
- 7 (1) 50 percent of the grant amount if the community
- 8 mental health program to be supported by the grant provides
- 9 services and treatment in a county with a population of less than
- 10 <u>250,000; or</u>
- 11 (2) 100 percent of the grant amount if the community
- 12 mental health program to be supported by the grant provides
- 13 services and treatment in a county with a population of 250,000 or
- 14 more.
- 15 <u>(d-2)</u> For a community mental health program that provides
- 16 services and treatment in more than one county, the commission
- 17 shall condition each grant provided under this section on a
- 18 potential grant recipient providing funds from non-state sources in
- 19 a total amount at least equal to:
- 20 (1) 50 percent of the grant amount if the largest
- 21 county in which the community mental health program to be supported
- 22 by the grant provides services and treatment has a population of
- 23 less than 250,000; or
- 24 (2) 100 percent of the grant amount if the largest
- 25 county in which the community mental health program to be supported
- 26 by the grant provides services and treatment has a population of
- 27 250,000 or more.

- 1 SECTION 2. Sections 531.0992(b) and (g), Government Code, 2 are repealed.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
