## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT

- 2 relating to a study on freestanding emergency medical care
- 3 facilities.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. (a) In this Act:
- 6 (1) "Commission" means the Health and Human Services
- 7 Commission.
- 8 (2) "Facility" means a freestanding emergency medical
- 9 care facility licensed under Chapter 254, Health and Safety Code.
- 10 (b) The commission shall conduct a study on freestanding
- 11 emergency medical care facilities that:
- 12 (1) reviews the impact facilities have on medically
- 13 underserved and rural areas of this state;
- 14 (2) reviews the impact facilities have on rural
- 15 hospitals in this state;
- 16 (3) reviews the impact facilities have on hospital
- 17 emergency rooms in this state;
- 18 (4) reviews complaints filed against facilities;
- 19 (5) examines the reasons facilities have closed;
- 20 (6) examines the reasons facilities have filed
- 21 petitions for bankruptcy;
- 22 (7) examines patient protections provided by
- 23 facilities and patient health care coverage available at the
- 24 facilities;

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- 1 (8) examines the location of facilities, the growth
- 2 patterns of new facilities, and the proximity of the new facilities
- 3 to hospital emergency rooms; and
- 4 (9) identifies gaps in emergency medical care
- 5 treatment that are filled by facilities.
- 6 (c) Not later than December 1, 2020, the commission shall
- 7 prepare and submit to the governor, lieutenant governor, speaker of
- 8 the house of representatives, and members of the legislature  ${\tt a}$
- 9 written report that includes a summary of the results of the study
- 10 conducted under this section and any legislative recommendations
- 11 based on the study.
- 12 (d) This Act expires September 1, 2021.
- 13 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
