- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 42, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 42.25191 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 42.25191. APPROPRIATION FOR PUBLIC EDUCATION. In each
- 8 biennial General Appropriations Act, the legislature shall set the
- 9 basic allotment under Section 42.101 and the dollar amount
- 10 guaranteed level of state and local funds per weighted student per
- 11 cent of tax effort ("GL") under Section 42.302 for each state fiscal
- 12 year at:
- 13 (1) the amounts necessary for the amount of state
- 14 funds to which all school districts are jointly entitled under this
- 15 chapter, together with state funds to which all school districts
- 16 are jointly entitled for that state fiscal year under any other law
- 17 that provides funding for the general maintenance and operation of
- 18 the system of public free schools, to comply with the minimum
- 19 requirement of Section 1, Article VII, Texas Constitution; or
- 20 (2) amounts greater than the amounts specified by
- 21 Subdivision (1).
- 22 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2020, but only
- 23 if the constitutional amendment proposed by the 86th Legislature,
- 24 Regular Session, 2019, requiring the state to pay at least 50

- 1 percent of the cost of maintaining and operating the public school
- 2 system and prohibiting the comptroller from certifying legislation
- 3 containing an appropriation for public education unless the
- 4 requirement is met, is approved by the voters. If that amendment is
- 5 not approved by the voters, this Act has no effect.
