Subchapter B, Chapter 7, Education Code, is amended by adding Section 7.041 to read as follows: 6 7 Sec. 7.041. STUDENT MENTAL HEALTH DIVISION. The commissioner by rule shall establish the student mental health 8 9 division within the agency to: (1) develop and administer a plan to identify, 10 leverage, and align existing agency resources to promote the 11 academic success of students with mental health needs, including 12 13 students in special education programs under Subchapter A, Chapter 14 29; and 15 <u>statewide</u> (2) promote strong local and 16 school-community partnerships by coordinating with community-based mental health services providers, youth services providers, and 17 school district resources, including school counselors, and with 18 relevant state agencies, including the Health and Human Services 19 Commission, the Department of State Health Services, the Department 20 of Family and Protective Services, the Texas Workforce Commission, 21 and the Texas Juvenile Justice Department. 22 SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date 23 of this Act, the commissioner of education shall adopt rules 24

establishing the student mental health division within the Texas
Education Agency as required by Section 7.041, Education Code, as
added by this Act.

4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
