BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-20 SECTION 1. Sections 418.005(a), (b), (c), and (e), Government Code, are amended to read as follows: 1-21 1-22 1-23 (a)

This section applies only to:

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(1) an elected law enforcement officer or county judge, or an appointed public officer of the state or of a political 1-24 1-25 subdivision, who has management or supervisory responsibilities 1-26 and:
