5	SECTION 1. Section 382.203(a), Health and Safety Code, is

7	(a) The inspection and maintenance program applies to any

12	(2) at least two and less than 25 years old; or
13	(3) subject to test-on-resale requirements under

15	SECTION 2. Section 547.605(c), Transportation Code, is
16	amended to read as follows:
17	(c) The owner or operator of a motor vehicle or motor
18	vehicle engine, of a model year after 1967, that is equipped with an
19	exhaust emission system:
20	(1) shall maintain the system in good working
21	condition;
22	(2) shall use the system when the motor vehicle or
23	motor vehicle engine is operated; [and]
24	(3) may not remove the system or a part of the system

1 or intentionally make the system inoperable in this state, unless 2 the owner or operator removes the system or part to install another 3 system or part intended to be equally effective in reducing 4 atmospheric emissions; and

- 5 (4) if the motor vehicle is a diesel-powered passenger 6 car or light truck, may not modify or reprogram the system or a part 7 of the system in a manner that the owner or operator knows or should 8 know will increase the motor vehicle's capacity to emit soot, 9 smoke, or other particulate matter.
