Section 547.605(c), Transportation Code, 14 is amended to read as follows: 15 (c) The owner or operator of a motor vehicle or motor 16 vehicle engine, of a model year after 1967, that is equipped with an 17 exhaust emission system: 18 (1) shall maintain the system in good working 19 20 condition; 21 (2) shall use the system when the motor vehicle or 22 motor vehicle engine is operated; [and] 23 (3) may not remove the system or a part of the system or intentionally make the system inoperable in this state, unless 24

No. 892 the owner or operator removes the system or part to install another 1 system or part intended to be equally effective in reducing 2 3 atmospheric emissions; and 4 (4) if the motor vehicle is diesel-powered, may not 5 modify or reprogram the system or a part of the system in a manner 6 that the owner or operator knows or should know will increase the motor vehicle's capacity to emit soot, smoke, or other particulate 7 8 matter.
