- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 12.081(a), Water Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (a) The powers and duties of all districts and authorities
- 8 created under Article III, Section 52 and Article XVI, Section 59 of
- 9 the Texas Constitution are subject to the continuing right of
- 10 supervision of the State of Texas by and through the commission or
- 11 its successor, and this supervision may include but is not limited
- 12 to the authority to:
- 13 (1) inquire into the qualifications [competence,
- 14 fitness, and reputation] of the officers and directors of any
- 15 district or authority;
- 16 (2) require, on its own motion or on complaint by any
- 17 person, audits or other financial information, inspections,
- 18 evaluations, and engineering reports;
- 19 (3) issue subpoenas for witnesses to carry out its
- 20 authority under this subsection;
- 21 (4) institute investigations and hearings using
- 22 examiners appointed by the commission;
- 23 (5) issue rules necessary to supervise the districts
- 24 and authorities, except that such rules shall not apply to water

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- 1 quality ordinances adopted by any river authority which meet or
- 2 exceed minimum requirements established by the commission; and
- 3 (6) the right of supervision granted herein shall not
- 4 apply to matters relating to electric utility operations.
- 5 SECTION 2. Sections 49.102(e) and (f), Water Code, are
- 6 amended to read as follows:
- 7 (e) If a majority of the votes cast in the election favor the
- 8 creation of the district, then the temporary board shall declare
- 9 that the district is created and enter the result in its minutes.
- 10 If a majority of the votes cast in the election are against the
- 11 creation of the district, the temporary board shall declare that
- 12 the district was defeated and enter the result in its minutes. A
- 13 copy of the order shall be filed with the commission not later than
- 14 the 30th day after the date of the election.
- 15 (f) The order canvassing the results of the confirmation
- 16 election shall contain a description of the district's boundaries
- 17 and shall be filed with the executive director and in the deed
- 18 records of the county or counties in which the district is located
- 19 not later than the 30th day after the date of the election.
- SECTION 3. Section 49.195(a), Water Code, is amended to
- 21 read as follows:
- 22 (a) The executive director may review the audit report of
- 23 each district. After reviewing the audit report, the executive
- 24 director may request additional information from the district. The
- 25 district shall provide the additional information not later than
- 26 the 60th day after the date the request was received, unless the
- 27 executive director extends the time allowed for the district to

- 1 provide additional information for good cause.
- 2 SECTION 4. Section 49.196(a), Water Code, is amended to
- 3 read as follows:
- 4 (a) The executive director may review and investigate a
- 5 district's financial records and may conduct an on-site audit of a
- 6 <u>district's financial information</u>. The executive director shall
- 7 have access to all vouchers, receipts, district fiscal and
- 8 financial records, and other district records the executive
- 9 director considers necessary.
- 10 SECTION 5. Title 2, Water Code, is amended by adding
- 11 Subtitle G to read as follows:
- 12 SUBTITLE G. MISCELLANEOUS PROVISIONS
- 13 CHAPTER 39. STANDARDS FOR SUPERVISION OF WATER DISTRICTS IN
- 14 CERTAIN AREAS
- 15 Sec. 39.0101. STANDARDS FOR SURFACE WATER AND GROUNDWATER
- 16 MANAGEMENT IN CERTAIN AREAS. (a) This section applies to a county:
- 17 (1) bordering the Rio Grande;
- 18 (2) overlying the Edwards-Trinity Aquifer; and
- 19 (3) with a population greater than 40,000.
- 20 (b) To provide the best available science in the event a
- 21 conservation and reclamation district is created under the
- 22 <u>authority of Section 59</u>, Article XVI, Texas Constitution, in the
- 23 area described by Subsection (a), the Texas Water Development
- 24 Board, in coordination with the Texas Commission on Environmental
- 25 Quality, shall adopt standards for water management by a
- 26 conservation and reclamation district in the area described by
- 27 Subsection (a).
