1-21 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-22 AN ACT

1-23 relating to exhibits presented at the Alamo complex.  
1-24 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:  
1-25 SECTION 1. Subchapter I, Chapter 31, Natural Resources  
1-26 Code, is amended by adding Section 31.4512 to read as follows:  
1-27 Sec. 31.4512. EXHIBITS IN ALAMO COMPLEX. (a) In this  
1-28 section:  
1-29 (1) "Alamo complex" means the municipal and state  
1-30 property, whether owned or leased, consisting of and adjacent to  
1-31 the Alamo, including the Alamo Mission, the Alamo compound, the  
1-32 Alamo Plaza, the Plaza de Valero, and the Long Barrack.  
1-33 (2) "Alamo compound" means the area of the original  
1-34 Alamo mission footprint contained within the walls of the mission  
1-35 as those walls stood in 1836.  
1-36 (b) The land office shall ensure that each exhibit presented  
1-37 in the Alamo compound has as its primary theme the 1836 Battle of  
1-38 the Alamo. The exhibit must include information on:  
1-39 (1) the lives of the individuals who defended the  
1-40 Alamo during the battle and the sacrifices made by those  
1-41 individuals for Texas independence and the freedom of Texans;  
1-42 (2) the impact of the battle on Texas history and  
1-43 culture; and  
1-44 (3) the pride felt by Texans with respect to the  
1-45 individuals who defended the Alamo during the battle.  
1-46 (c) The land office shall ensure that an exhibit featuring a  
1-47 historical period or individual unrelated to the 1836 Battle of the  
1-48 Alamo is presented at a location in the Alamo complex other than the  
1-49 Alamo compound.  
1-50 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
