AN ACT

2 relating to judicial review of certain workers' compensation 3 disputes.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Sections 410.252(a) and (d), Labor Code, are 6 amended to read as follows:

7 (a) A party may seek judicial review by filing suit not 8 later than the <u>60th</u> [45th] day after the date on which the division 9 mailed the party the decision of the appeals panel. For purposes of 10 this section, the mailing date is considered to be the fifth day 11 after the date the decision of the appeals panel was filed with the 12 division.

(d) If a suit is initially filed within the <u>60-day</u> [45-day]
period in Subsection (a), and is transferred under Subsection (c),
the suit is considered to be timely filed in the court to which it is
transferred.

17 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only 18 to a suit for judicial review filed on or after the effective date 19 of this Act. A suit for judicial review filed before the effective 20 date of this Act is covered by the law as it existed on the date the 21 suit was filed, and the former law is continued in effect for that 22 purpose.

23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
