| 13 | and Safety Performance Standards; Guidelines for Early Care and    |
| 14 | Education Programs; and                                            |
| 15 | (2) the nutrition standards in the Child and Adult                 |
| 16 | Care Food Program administered by the Department of Agriculture.   |
| 17 | (e-4) A day-care center or registered family home is not           |
| 18 | required to participate in or comply with the reporting            |
| 19 | requirements of the Child and Adult Care Food Program administered |
| 20 | by the Department of Agriculture.                                  |
| 21 | SECTION 2. As soon as practicable after the effective date         |
| 22 | of this Act, the executive commissioner of the Health and Human    |
| 23 | Services Commission shall adopt the rules necessary to implement   |
