Sections 316.092(a), (b), and (c), Government Code, are amended to read as follows: 7 (a) Not later than September 1 of each even-numbered year 8 [preceding the year in which this section expires as provided by 9 Subsection (e)], the speaker of the house of representatives and 10 11 the lieutenant governor shall appoint a select committee as 12 follows: 13 (1) the speaker of the house of representatives shall 14 appoint five members of the house of representatives as members of the committee; and 15 (2) the lieutenant governor shall appoint five members 16 of the senate as members of the committee. 17 18 (b) For the purposes of Section 49-g(c-2), Article III, Texas Constitution, not later than December 1 of each even-numbered 19 year [preceding the year in which this section expires as provided 20 21 by Subsection (e)], the select committee shall determine and adopt for the next state fiscal biennium a sufficient balance of the fund 22 23 in an amount that the committee estimates will ensure an appropriate amount of revenue available in the fund. 24 Τn

No. 962 determining the sufficient balance for that fiscal biennium, the 1 committee shall consider: 2 (1) the history of fund balances; 3 4 (2) the history of transfers to the fund; 5 (3) estimated fund balances during that fiscal 6 biennium; (4) estimated transfers to the fund to occur during 7 that fiscal biennium; 8 information available to the committee regarding 9 (5) state highway congestion and funding demands; and 10 11 any other information requested by the committee (6) regarding the state's financial condition. 12 (c) On or before October 1 of each even-numbered year 13 [preceding the year in which this section expires as provided by 14 15 Subsection (e)], the comptroller shall provide to the select 16 committee the comptroller's projection of the amounts to be 17 transferred to the fund during the next state fiscal biennium. SECTION 2. The following provisions of the Government Code 18 are repealed: 19 20 (1) Section 316.092(e); (2) Sections 316.093(e) and (f); and 21 (3) Section 404.0241(d). 22 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019. 23

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
