- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 42, Human Resources Code,
- 6 is amended by adding Section 42.0415 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 42.0415. STANDARD LICENSE REQUIREMENTS; WAIVER
- 8 PROHIBITED. (a) The commission shall issue or renew a license of a
- 9 child-care facility that is operated by or under a contract with
- 10 United States Immigration and Customs Enforcement to enforce
- 11 federal immigration laws and that detains children, in the same
- 12 manner and subject to the same requirements as the commission
- 13 issues or renews a license for any other child-care facility under
- 14 this chapter.
- 15 (b) The commission may not waive any licensing requirement,
- 16 including minimum standards, for a child-care facility described by
- 17 Subsection (a).
- SECTION 2. Section 42.0415, Human Resources Code, as added
- 19 by this Act, applies only to a license issued or renewed on or after
- 20 the effective date of this Act.
- 21 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 22 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 23 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 24 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
