The lieutenant governor and the speaker of the house of 16 (c) representatives shall jointly designate a chair or, alternatively, 17 designate two co-chairs from among the committee membership. 18 The committee may adopt rules necessary to carry out the 19 (d) committee's duties under this section. 20 21 Not later than December 1, 2020, the committee shall (e) report to the governor and the legislature the findings of the study 22 23 and any recommendations developed by the committee under this 24 section.
