4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 33, Human Resources Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 33.0024 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 33.0024. DISASTER SNAP. (a) In this section,
8	"program" means the program to provide supplemental nutrition
9	assistance benefits to victims of a disaster as authorized by 7
10	U.S.C. Section 2014.
11	(b) The commission shall:
12	(1) in collaboration with local government officials:
13	(A) create a directory of local points of contact
14	for the operation of the program;
15	(B) determine the best method for communication
16	between the commission and local government officials regarding the
17	program; and
18	(C) evaluate, develop, and maintain a list of
19	potential sites for in-person application for program benefits that
20	<pre>meet federal requirements;</pre>
21	(2) enter into a memorandum of understanding with
22	local government agencies regarding the location of sites for
23	in-person application for program benefits; and
24	(3) provide information regarding the program and

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1 strategies for effective collaboration between local governments 2 and the commission to local government officials in coastal 3 counties by hosting webinars, conducting conference calls, or 4 holding in-person meetings. 5 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 6 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 7 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this

9 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.

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
