A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to the establishment of a work group to study local
- 3 restrictions that impede disaster recovery efforts.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. DEFINITION. In this Act, "work group" means the
- 6 work group established under this Act.
- 7 SECTION 2. WORK GROUP ESTABLISHED. (a) The work group is
- 8 composed of representatives of local, state, and federal
- 9 governmental entities and private entities who are appointed by the
- 10 lieutenant governor and the speaker of the house of
- 11 representatives.
- 12 (b) Appointments to the work group under Subsection (a) of
- 13 this section must be made not later than November 1, 2019.
- 14 SECTION 3. WORK GROUP DUTIES. (a) The work group shall
- 15 conduct a study on local restrictions that impede disaster recovery
- 16 efforts.
- 17 (b) The study conducted under Subsection (a) of this section
- 18 must include:
- 19 (1) an overview of official actions by governing
- 20 bodies of political subdivisions and requirements imposed by deed
- 21 restrictions or property owners' associations that impede state and
- 22 federal disaster recovery efforts in this state; and
- 23 (2) recommendations for minimizing the effect of the
- 24 official actions and requirements described by Subdivision (1) of

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- 1 this subsection on state and federal disaster recovery efforts in
- 2 this state.
- 3 SECTION 4. REPORT. Not later than November 1, 2020, the
- 4 work group shall submit a written report to the members of the
- 5 legislature with the results of the study required under Section 3
- 6 of this Act.
- 7 SECTION 5. EXPIRATION DATE. This Act expires and the work
- 8 group is abolished January 1, 2021.
- 9 SECTION 6. EFFECTIVE DATE. This Act takes effect September
- 10 1, 2019.
