## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 552.323(b), Government Code, is amended
- 6 to read as follows:
- 7 (b) In an action brought under Section 552.324, the court
- 8 may <u>not</u> assess costs of litigation <u>or</u> [<del>and</del>] reasonable attorney's
- 9 fees incurred by a plaintiff or defendant who substantially
- 10 prevails unless the court finds the action or the defense of the
- 11 <u>action was groundless in fact or law</u>. In exercising its discretion
- 12 under this subsection, the court shall consider whether the conduct
- 13 of the governmental body had a reasonable basis in law and whether
- 14 the litigation was brought in good faith.
- 15 SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 16 to an action brought on or after the effective date of this Act. An
- 17 action brought before the effective date of this Act is governed by
- 18 the law as it existed immediately before the effective date of this
- 19 Act, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 20 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
