AN ACT relating to an increase in the basic allotment and classroom 2

3 teacher salaries.

Δ BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

- SECTION 1. Section 42.101(a), Education Code, is amended to 5
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 For each student in average daily attendance, not
- 8 including the time students spend each day in special education
- programs in an instructional arrangement other than mainstream or 9
- 10 career and technology education programs, for which an additional
- allotment is made under Subchapter C, a district is entitled to an 11
- allotment equal to the lesser of \$5,765 [\$4,765] or the amount that 12
- 13 results from the following formula:
- $A = \$5,765 \ [\$4,765] \ X \ (DCR/MCR)$ 14
- 15 where:
- "A" is the allotment to which a district is entitled; 16
- 17 "DCR" is the district's compressed tax rate, which is the
- 18 product of the state compression percentage, as determined under
- Section 42.2516, multiplied by the maintenance and operations tax 19
- rate adopted by the district for the 2005 tax year; and 20
- "MCR" is the state maximum compressed tax rate, which is the 21
- product of the state compression percentage, as determined under 22
- Section 42.2516, multiplied by \$1.50. 23
- 24 SECTION 2. Subchapter E, Chapter 42, Education Code,

- 1 amended by adding Section 42.2512 to read as follows:
- 2 Sec. 42.2512. ADDITIONAL STATE AID FOR TEACHER SALARIES.
- 3 (a) A school district, including a school district that is
- 4 otherwise ineligible for state aid under this chapter, is entitled
- 5 to state aid for classroom teacher salaries in an amount, as
- 6 determined by the commissioner, equal to 50 percent of the amount of
- 7 additional funds to which the district is entitled due to the
- 8 increase made by ___.B. No. ____, Acts of the 86th Legislature,
- 9 Regular Session, 2019, to the basic allotment under Section 42.101.
- 10 (b) A determination by the commissioner under this section
- 11 is final and may not be appealed.
- 12 <u>(c)</u> The commissioner may adopt rules to implement this
- 13 section.
- 14 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
