5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 1301, Occupations Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 1301.059 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 1301.059. PLUMBING ON CERTAIN PRIVATE PROPERTY.
8	(a) A person is not required to be licensed under this chapter to

- 9 perform plumbing work consisting of installing, servicing, or
- 10 repairing service mains, service lines, appurtenances, equipment,
- or appliances that provide water, sewer, or storm drainage services
- 12 on private property in an area that extends from a public right of
- 13 way or public easement to not less than five feet from a building or
- 14 <u>structure.</u>
- (b) This section does not apply to plumbing work performed
- 16 on private property designated for use as a one-family or
- 17 two-family dwelling.
- 18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
