- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 1301, Occupations Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Section 1301.059 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 1301.059. PLUMBING ON CERTAIN PRIVATE PROPERTY. (a) A
- 8 person is not required to be licensed under this chapter to perform
- 9 plumbing work consisting of installing, servicing, or repairing
- 10 service mains, service lines, appurtenances, equipment, or
- 11 appliances that provide water, sewer, or storm drainage services on
- 12 private property in an area that extends from a public right of way
- 13 or public easement to not less than five feet from a building or
- 14 structure.
- 15 (b) This section does not apply to plumbing work performed
- 16 on private property designated for use as a one-family or
- 17 two-family dwelling.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
