- 21 county shall appoint the directors of the corporation. If a single
- 22 municipality authorizes the creation of a spaceport development
- 23 corporation under Section 507.003(2), the governing body of the
- 24 municipality shall appoint the directors of the corporation.

- 1 <u>(b-1)</u> If more than one political subdivision authorizes the creation of a spaceport development corporation, the governing bodies of the political subdivisions shall appoint the directors through written agreement between the governing bodies.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
