- 6 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 7 SECTION 1. Subchapter A, Chapter 1301, Insurance Code, is
- 8 amended by adding Section 1301.0059 to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 1301.0059. COMMUNICATION OF PREFERRED PROVIDER STATUS
- 10 OF FREESTANDING EMERGENCY MEDICAL CARE FACILITIES. It is an unfair
- 11 method of competition or an unfair or deceptive act or practice
- 12 under Chapter 541 for an insurer to prevent, by contract or
- 13 otherwise, a freestanding emergency medical care facility that is a
- 14 preferred provider from communicating with the public that the
- 15 facility is in the insurer's preferred provider network.
- 16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
