9	(1) "Major information resources project" has the
10	meaning assigned by Section 2054.003.
11	(2) "Sensitive personal information" has the meaning
12	assigned by Section 521.002, Business & Commerce Code.
13	(b) A vendor awarded a services contract by a state agency
14	may not assign the vendor's rights under the contract to a third
15	party unless the assignment is approved by the state agency.
16	(c) At least 14 days before a state agency rejects or
17	approves a vendor's proposed assignment under Subsection (b), the
18	state agency shall notify the Legislative Budget Board of the
19	<pre>proposed assignment if the contract subject to the assignment:</pre>
20	(1) is for a major information resources project; or
21	(2) involves storing, receiving, processing,
22	transmitting, disposing of, or accessing sensitive personal
23	information in a foreign country.
