1-27 relating to notice and approval of the assignment of vendor's
 1-28 rights under state agency contracts for services.

1-29 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-30 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 2262, Government Code, is
 1-31 amended by adding Section 2262.056 to read as follows:

1-32 Sec. 2262.056. APPROVAL REQUIRED FOR ASSIGNMENT OF SERVICES
 1-33 CONTRACTS. (a) In this section:

1-34 (1) "Major information resources project" has the
 1-35 meaning assigned by Section 2054.003.

1-36 (2) "Sensitive personal information" has the meaning
 1-37 assigned by Section 521.002, Business & Commerce Code.

1-38 (b) A vendor awarded a services contract by a state agency
 1-39 may not assign the vendor's rights under the contract to a third
 1-40 party unless the assignment is approved by the state agency.

1-41 (c) At least 14 days before a state agency rejects or
 1-42 approves a vendor's proposed assignment under Subsection (b), the
 1-43 state agency shall notify the Legislative Budget Board of the
 1-44 proposed assignment if the contract subject to the assignment:

1-45 (1) is for a major information resources project; or

1-46 (2) involves storing, receiving, processing,
 1-47 transmitting, disposing of, or accessing sensitive personal
 1-48 information in a foreign country.

1-49 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
 1-50 a contract entered into or renewed on or after the effective date of
 1-51 this Act.

1-52 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
