 1-17 AN ACT

1-18 relating to the authority of certain municipalities to annex an
 1-19 enclave.

1-20 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-21 SECTION 1. Section 43.0115(a), Local Government Code, is
 1-22 amended to read as follows:

1-23 (a) This section applies only to a municipality that:

1-24 (1) is wholly or partly located in a county in which a
 1-25 majority of the population of two or more municipalities, each with
 1-26 a population of 225,000 [~~300,000~~] or more, are located; and

1-27 (2) proposes to annex an area that:

1-28 (A) is wholly surrounded by a municipality and
 1-29 within the municipality's extraterritorial jurisdiction; and

1-30 (B) has fewer than 100 dwelling units.

1-31 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
 1-32 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
 1-33 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
 1-34 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
 1-35 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
