- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 22.107(a), Education Code, is amended to
- 5 read as follows:
- 6 (a) A school district shall pay each full-time district
- 7 employee, other than an administrator or an employee subject to the
- 8 minimum salary schedule under Section 21.402, an amount at least
- 9 equal to \$5,500 [\$500].
- SECTION 2. Section 42.2513, Education Code, is amended by
- 11 amending Subsection (a) and adding Subsection (a-1) to read as
- 12 follows:
- 13 (a) A school district, including a school district that is
- 14 otherwise ineligible for state aid under this chapter, is entitled
- 15 to state aid in an amount equal to the sum of:
- 16 (1) the product of \$5,500 [\$500] multiplied by the
- 17 number of full-time district employees, other than administrators
- 18 or employees subject to the minimum salary schedule under Section
- 19 21.402; and
- 20 (2) the product of \$250 multiplied by the number of
- 21 part-time district employees, other than administrators.
- 22 <u>(a-1) A school district that is required to take action</u>
- 23 under Chapter 41 to reduce its wealth per student to the equalized
- 24 wealth level is entitled to a credit, in the amount of state aid to

- 1 which the district is entitled under this section, against the
- 2 total amount required under Section 41.093 for the district to
- 3 purchase attendance credits.
- 4 SECTION 3. This Act applies beginning with the 2019-2020
- 5 school year.
- 6 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
