- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 54.910(b), Education Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (b) If the designated beneficiary is not able to exercise
- 8 signature authority over an account or chooses to establish an
- 9 account but not exercise signature authority [of the account is a
- 10 minor or has a custodian or other fiduciary appointed for the
- 11 purpose of managing the minor's financial affairs], the parent,
- 12 legal quardian, [or custodian] or other fiduciary of the
- 13 beneficiary may serve as the participant if [that form of ownership
- 14 is] permitted [or not prohibited] by Section 529A, Internal Revenue
- 15 Code.
- 16 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 17 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 18 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 19 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 20 Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
