5	SECTION 1. Section 59.001, Property Code, is amended by
6	adding Subdivision (4-a) to read as follows:
7	(4-a) "Vehicle storage facility" has the meaning

9	SECTION 2. Section 59.043(a), Property Code, is amended to

11	(a) The lessor's notice to the tenant of the claim must

- 3 (5) a statement underlined or printed in conspicuous
- 4 bold print requesting a tenant who is in military service to notify

- 7 SECTION 3. Chapter 59, Property Code, is amended by adding
- 8 Subchapter D to read as follows:
- 9 SUBCHAPTER D. TOWING OF CERTAIN PROPERTY TO VEHICLE STORAGE
- 10 <u>FACILITY</u>
- 11 Sec. 59.051. APPLICABILITY. This subchapter applies only
- 12 to:
- 13 (1) a motor vehicle subject to Chapter 501,
- 14 Transportation Code;
- 15 (2) a motorboat or vessel for which a certificate of
- 16 title is required under Subchapter B, Chapter 31, Parks and
- 17 Wildlife Code;
- 18 (3) a trailer for which a title or registration is
- 19 required under Chapter 501 or 502, Transportation Code; or
- 20 (4) a motor vehicle, motorboat, vessel, or trailer
- 21 registered or titled outside this state.
- Sec. 59.052. TRANSFER OF CERTAIN PROPERTY TO VEHICLE
- 23 STORAGE FACILITY. Notwithstanding Subchapter C, a lessor who takes
- 24 possession of property to which this subchapter applies to enforce
- 25 a lien under this chapter may transfer possession of the property
- 26 and have the property towed to a vehicle storage facility for
- 27 disposition by the vehicle storage facility under Subchapter D,

- 1 Chapter 2303, Occupations Code, if:
- 2 (1) the transfer of possession and towing is
- 3 authorized under a written rental agreement between the lessor and

- 5 (2) the lessor gives written notice of the lessor's

- 14 Sec. 59.053. LIEN EXTINGUISHED. A lessor's lien on
- 15 property towed to a vehicle storage facility under Section 59.052
- 16 is extinguished when the property is towed from the self-service
- 17 storage facility.
- 18 Sec. 59.054. OTHER RIGHTS AND REMEDIES NOT AFFECTED.
- 19 Except as provided by Section 59.053, this subchapter does not
- 20 affect any right or remedy of the lessor at law or in equity.
- Sec. 59.055. LESSOR'S LIABILITY FOR PROPERTY. A lessor is
- 22 not liable to a tenant for any damage to property that the lessor
- 23 has towed under Section 59.052 that occurs during the tow or after
- 24 the property is towed from the self-service storage facility.
- 25 SECTION 4. Chapter 2303, Occupations Code, is amended by
- 26 adding Subchapter E to read as follows:

- 1 SUBCHAPTER E. ACCEPTANCE AND DISPOSITION OF CERTAIN PROPERTY FROM
- 2 SELF-SERVICE STORAGE FACILITY
- 3 Sec. 2303.201. DEFINITIONS. In this subchapter, "lessor"
- 4 and "self-service storage facility" have the meanings assigned by
- 5 Section 59.001, Property Code.
- 6 Sec. 2303.202. APPLICABILITY. This subchapter applies only
- 7 to property described by Section 59.051, Property Code.
- 8 Sec. 2303.203. ACCEPTANCE OF PROPERTY. A vehicle storage
- 9 facility shall accept property from a lessor who has transferred
- 10 possession of the property from a self-service storage facility to
- 11 the vehicle storage facility under Section 59.052, Property Code.
- 12 Sec. 2303.204. DISPOSITION OF PROPERTY. A vehicle storage
- 13 facility that accepts property under Section 2303.203 may dispose
- 14 of the property in the manner provided by Subchapter D for a vehicle
- 15 received by a facility as described by Section 2303.151.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
