Section 15.052(b), Election Code, is amended to read as follows: 6 7 (b) The official confirmation notice response form must: (1) provide spaces for the voter to include all of the 8 9 information that a person must include in an application to register to vote under Section 13.002; [and] 10 11 (2) describe the requirements of Section 15.054, 12 provide a space for the voter to indicate if the voter is exempt from those requirements, and provide a space to indicate the reason 13 for an exemption, if any; and 14 15 (3) be postage prepaid and preaddressed for delivery 16 to the registrar. SECTION 2. Section 15.053(a), Election Code, is amended to 17 read as follows: 18 (a) Not later than the 30th day after the 19 date a confirmation notice is mailed, the voter shall submit to the 20 registrar a written, signed response to the notice that confirms 21 the voter's current residence. The response must contain: 22 23 (1) all of the information that a person must include 24 in an application to register to vote under Section 13.002; and

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(2) evidence that the voter's residence address is 1 2 established in compliance with Section 15.054 or an indication that 3 the voter is exempt from those requirements. SECTION 3. Subchapter C, Chapter 15, Election Code, is 4 5 amended by adding Section 15.054 to read as follows: Sec. 15.054. RESIDENCE FOR PURPOSES OF CONFIRMATION NOTICE 6 7 RESPONSE. (a) For purposes of Section 15.053, a person's residence is established at the first residence address, beginning with 8 Subdivision (1) and continuing through Subdivision (6), in the 9 10 following list that is applicable to the person: (1) the address stated on a driver's license issued to 11 12 the person by the Department of Public Safety that has not expired or, if the person has notified the department of a change of address 13 under Section 521.054, Transportation Code, the new address 14 15 contained in the notification; (2) the address stated on a personal identification 16 17 card issued to the person by the Department of Public Safety that has not expired or, if the person has notified the department of a 18 change of address under Section 521.054, Transportation Code, the 19 new address contained in the notification; 20 21 (3) the address stated on a license to carry a concealed handgun issued to the person by the Department of Public 22 Safety that has not expired or, if the person has notified the 23 24 department of a change of address under Section 411.181, Government Code, the new address contained in the notification; 25 26 (4) an address corresponding to a residence at which 27 the person receives mail;

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1	(5) the address the person claims as a homestead in
2	this state; or
3	(6) the registration address of a vehicle the person
4	owns.
5	(b) A person whose residence in this state has no address
6	may establish residence under this section by executing an
7	affidavit stating that the person's residence in this state has no
8	address, providing a concise description of the location of the
9	person's residence, and delivering the affidavit to the registrar
10	with the person's response to the confirmation notice.
11	(c) The address described by Subsection (a)(4) may not be a
12	commercial post office box or similar location that does not
13	correspond to a residence.
14	(d) This section does not apply to:
15	(1) a person who is a member of the armed forces of the
16	United States or the spouse or a dependent of a member;
17	(2) a person enrolled as a full-time student at an
18	institution of higher education;
19	(3) a person whose address is confidential under
20	Subchapter C, Chapter 56, Code of Criminal Procedure;
21	(4) a federal judge, state judge, or spouse of a
22	federal or state judge whose driver's license includes the street
23	address of a courthouse under Section 521.121, Transportation Code;
24	or
25	(5) a peace officer whose driver's license omits the
26	officer's actual residence address under Section 521.1211,
27	Transportation Code.

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1	(e) Subsection (a)(1) does not apply to a person who holds a
2	commercial driver's license under Subchapter C, Chapter 522,
3	Transportation Code.
4	(f) The secretary of state shall adopt rules as necessary to
5	implement this section.
6	SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
