Section 39.0241, Education Code, is amended by 7 adding Subsection (a-2) to read as follows: (a-2) This subsection applies only to an assessment 8 9 instrument authorized under Section 39.025(a-1) or Section 39.025(a-2), as added by Chapter 1036 (H.B. 1613), Acts of the 84th 10 Legislature, Regular Session, 2015, for use as an alternate 11 assessment instrument for purposes of satisfying the requirements 12 concerning an end-of-course assessment instrument. 13 14 commissioner shall designate performance standards for student performance on each assessment instrument subject to this 15 16 subsection in the same manner as the commissioner designates performance standards for student performance on each 17 end-of-course assessment instrument listed in Section 39.023(c). 18 SECTION 2. Section 39.053, Education Code, is amended by 19 20 adding Subsection (c-4) to read as follows: 21 (c-4) The commissioner by rule shall determine a method for appropriately crediting a student for growth under Subsection 22 23 (c)(2) based on the student's performance, as determined under the

- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
