A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the removal of certain alcoholic beverages that become
3	unfit for consumption after a natural disaster.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. The heading to Subchapter A, Chapter 109,
6	Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended to read as follows:
7	SUBCHAPTER A. SALVAGED AND INSURED LOSSES; UNINSURED LOSSES
8	SECTION 2. Subchapter A, Chapter 109, Alcoholic Beverage
9	Code, is amended by adding Section 109.09 to read as follows:
10	Sec. 109.09. REMOVAL OF UNINSURED BEVERAGES UNFIT FOR
11	CONSUMPTION. (a) Uninsured ale, malt liquor, or beer that becomes
12	unfit for public consumption, as described by Section 103.07(b),
13	may be removed from the inventory of a retailer if the holder of the
14	brewer's permit or manufacturer's license who manufactured the
15	beverage and the wholesaler or distributor that distributed the
16	beverage jointly determine that the beverage:
17	(1) became unfit for public consumption as the result
18	of a natural disaster in an area declared to be a disaster under
19	Section 418.014, Government Code; and
20	(2) should be removed from the inventory of the
21	<u>retailer.</u>
22	(b) A manufacturer or brewer and a wholesaler or distributor
23	who agree to the removal of a beverage under Subsection (a) must
24	hold the retailer from whose inventory the beverage is removed

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1	harmless for the cost of the replacement of the removed beverage.
2	(c) The commission by rule may provide requirements
3	governing the disposal or destruction by a retailer of uninsured
4	ale, malt liquor, or beer that is determined to be unfit for public
5	consumption under this section.

6 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
