4	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 402, Government Code, is
5	amended by adding Section 402.0351 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 402.0351. REQUIRED POSTING OF HUMAN TRAFFICKING SIGNS
7	AT TRANSPORTATION HUBS. (a) In this section, "transportation hub"
8	means a bus, bus stop, train, train station, rest area, or airport.
9	(b) The attorney general by rule shall prescribe the design
10	and content of a sign regarding services and assistance available
11	to victims of human trafficking to be displayed at transportation
12	hubs. The sign must be in both English and Spanish and include:
13	(1) the telephone number and Internet website of the
14	National Human Trafficking Resource Center; and
15	(2) the key indicators that a person is a victim of
16	human trafficking.
17	(c) A person who operates a transportation hub shall post a
18	sign described by Subsection (b) at the transportation hub. The
19	attorney general:
20	(1) by rule shall prescribe the manner the sign must be
21	displayed at the transportation hub; and
22	(2) shall enforce this section.
23	(d) In adopting the rules under Subsection (b), the attorney
24	general shall consult with the Texas Department of Transportation.

S.B. No. 1219 SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2019, the attorney general shall adopt the rules required by Section 402.0351, Government Code, as added by this Act.

4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2019.
