9	cartage permit may make deliveries to and collections from ultimate								
10	consumers in the same manner as the holder of a package store permit								
11	under Section 22.03.								
12	SECTION 2. Section 43.01, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is								
13	amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:								
14	(c) A package store, wine only package store, or wine and								
15	beer retailer's permittee who also holds a local cartage permit may								
16	make deliveries to and collections from customers in accordance								
17	with Section 22.03, 24.03, or 25.15, as appropriate.								
18	SECTION 3. Section 43.04, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is								
19	amended to read as follows:								
20	Sec. 43.04. ELIGIBILITY FOR PERMIT. The commission may								
21	issue a local cartage permit to a warehouse or transfer company or								
22	to a holder of a package store, wine only package store, wine and								
23	beer retailer's, or local distributor's permit.
